Faculty of Animal Science, Veterinary Science and Fisheries, Rampur, Chitwan is pleased to call for proposal for the research grants for 5 (five) students provided by Directorate of Livestock and Fisheries Development, Ministry of Land Management, Agriculture and Co-operatives, Bagmati Province to its postgraduate students (MVSc, MSc Ani. Sc. and MSc Fisheries) in accordance with its standard guidelines and research norms. The followings are the further points of elaboration regarding proposal preparation:

a. The proposal has been solely called for the postgraduate students (MVSc, MSc Ani. Sc. And MSc Fisheries) who are in the third semester.

b. The research work must be completed within the current fiscal year 2080/81. The research report needs to submit on or before 31st Jestha, 2081.

c. The research should be supervised by the relevant faculty of FAVF. Same faculty should not be the supervisor of more than 1 post graduate student. Thesis research of postgraduate students will be prioritized in granting the research fund.

d. Proposal must be prepared in any of the following thematic areasInfertility of cattle and buffalo, Low cost silage production, Sexed semen, Pregnancy diagnosis, Sex determination, *Coenurus cerebralis* larva in goat, Urolithiasis, Newborn mortality (30 days below), Toxic grass in upper hilly region, Productivity and nutritive value of fodder and pasture, Breed improvement of Yak and Nak, Kid mortality, Chick hatchability and mortality, Lumphy Skin disease, African Swine Fever, Pangas fish and research related to veterinary sciences, animal sciences and fisheries.

e. The maximum budget (including the taxes) for each proposal is NRs 100,000 (One Lakh only).

- f. The research grant will be availed after presentation of findings and submission of research report to Directorate of Livestock and Fisheries Development, Ministry of Land Management, Agriculture and Cooperatives, Bagmati Province.
- g. Supervisors are not given any extra remuneration thus budget under such heading is not acceptable.
- h. The deadline for submission of research proposal is 26th of the Asoj 2080 during office hours.

Specific Guidelines for Proposal Preparation

- 1. Title of the proposal including name and contact detail of candidate (e-mail; telephone) in the title page
- 2. Introduction (300 words)
- 3. Objectives (may be included at the end of the introduction)
- 4. Rational/Justification of the study
- 5. Materials and methods (400 words maximum)
- 6. Literature reviews (300 words maximum)
- 7. Expected outputs
- 8. Time frame
- 9. Budget
- 10. Limitation of the study
- 11. References
- 12. Annex information including log frame (if relevant)
- 13. Work plans
