**Revised announcement for applying in PhD program in Agricultural Economic**

**Fully funded PhD scholarships for Two students**

**Research Topic 1. Determinants of Himalayan medicinal plants demand and supply  
Research Topic 2. Medicinal plants and Himalayan transnational production networks**

Considering requests from a number of potential applicants belonging to some other subjects but relevant to the proposed research topics (e.g. M.Phil. or M.Sc. in Botany, Conservation Ecology, Environmental Science) to consider them for applying. The date of application submission for the PhD scholarships (initially published on Kantipur daily on 10<sup>th</sup> and 15<sup>th</sup> May 2014), the deadline has been further extended until 28<sup>th</sup> June 2014 with addition of Master or M. Phil. in Botany as the basic requirement. Other requirements and terms of application remain the same.

Each selected student would be provided with scholarship of about NRs. 35,000 per month for three years in addition to fees and field work costs (about NRs. 450,000) and opportunity to participate in two international conferences during the research period. During the course, each student may need to stay for six months in Denmark, enrolled at the University of Copenhagen, with opportunity for an additional degree from Denmark as well.
